



Rosso & Bianco wines pay tribute to Francis Ford Coppola's Italian heritage and his belief that wine belongs at the family table. Crafted for everyday enjoyment, these approachable, food-friendly wines bring together California fruit character with the warmth, generosity, and easygoing spirit of classic Italian dining.

TASTING NOTES

- Color: Deep ruby
- Nose: Black peppercorn, black fruit, violet, and subtle charred notes
- Palate: Dark fruit, black currant, clove, and earthy spice with a dense body, bold tannin structure, and generous finish

VINTAGE

The 2024 growing season featured warm inland days and cool evenings, with temperatures ranging from 38°C to 18°C. These natural temperature shifts promoted optimal ripening while preserving freshness, resulting in a Cabernet Sauvignon with concentrated fruit, bold structure, and balanced character.

WINEMAKING

Harvested at peak ripeness during the cool of the night, the wine underwent gentle extraction and controlled fermentation before 17 months of aging in American and French oak, adding layers of dark fruit, spice, and structure while preserving the wine's character and long finish.
